About The Writing Test The IELTS writing module varies depending on whether you are conducting an Academic Test (for university applications) or a General Test (usually for work/general migrations). In IELTS Academic you must explain the graph or diagram (Task 1) and write an essay (Task 2). In the IELTS General Training you must write a letter (Task 1) and write an essay (Task 2). Task 2 (essay) is actually worth more marks than Task 1 (graph or letter) so you have to spend 40 minutes of time on the essay and 20 minutes on the graph/letter. This tagging difference is represented in the number of words you must write, which is at least 150 for Tasks 1 and 250 for Task 2. You will be presented with the situation and you will have to write your letter explaining the situation or requesting information. This letter may be one of three styles: Personal/Semi-Formal/Formal/Your response should reflect the appropriate style. Here's an example question: You want to sell your television. You think a friend of yours might want to buy it from you. Write a letter to your friend. In your letter: Explain why you sell television/Describe television/Suggest date when your friend can come and see it Write at least 150 wordsYou do NOT need to write any addressAll your letters are as follows:Dear....., General Training Assignments 2 This is the same as writing an IELTS Academic module. IELTS Writing Assignment 1 In the first part, you are assigned a task based on some graphs or image information. You are expected to write a descriptive report of at least 150 words on the information provided. IELTS Writing Assignments 2 The second task is more demanding. You are expected to produce written arguments about a particular topic and to set your answers clearly, remembering some examples to support your points. You must write at least 250 words and, since Task 2 is longer than Task 1, you are advised to spend about 40 minutes on this task and 20 minutes on the first task. IELTS General Writing If you plan to take the GT module, the Writing test is different. You are allowed one hour to complete two tasks, of 150 and 250 words, as in the Academic module. However, Task 1 has always been a letter, while Task 2 is an essay based on a particular topic.
